Eligibility Requirements Under City Charter Section 404: To be appointed, applicants for the Council District 8 and 10 unanticipated vacancies:

1. The person must have been a citizen of the United States for at

least one year immediately preceding the date upon which the person is appointed.

2. The person must have been a resident of the City of San José and of the District represented by the person as member, for at least thirty (30) days immediately preceding the date of the person's appointment to fill a vacancy.
3. If appointed to such office, the person must have been a registered elector of the City of San José at the time of the person's appointment.

The incumbent must, at all times, during the term of office continue being:

1. a citizen of the United States;
2. a resident of the City of San José and of the District which he or she represents; and
3. a registered elector of the City.
